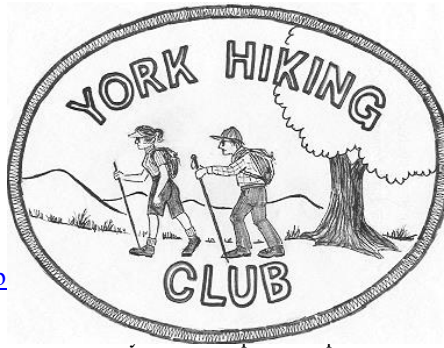

We start at Chestnut Grove Natural Area then take Turkey Hill Trail downhill to meet this ¾ mile loop. There are 2 small stream crossing using stepping stones so no wet feet! Trail has a small, gradual hill to climb to level area then somewhat steep descent (nothing major) to stream then mild uphill return to Chestnut Grove.
